
- Unplug the kit from the outlet before installing or uninstalling any parts.

Home Theater Kit Installation



1. Arrange the tubes on the ground and test the kit to ensure proper functionality before moving forward with the installation.

• **WARNING:** Disconnect all power from this kit before moving forward with the install. Reconnect power to the kit after finishing all connections.

DO NOT connect or plug in any cable or tube while you are installing this kit.

2. Once you know your kit is functioning properly and have determined your mounting locations, ensure the installation surface is free of dust, dirt, oil, or any other foreign objects that will not allow the included double sided tape to adhere properly. Rubbing alcohol or any type of cleaning solution will work best, but be sure the solution you are using will not affect the mounting surface.

3. Install the mounting clips to your installation surface using the included double sided tape. Be aware that over a long period of time this tape may cause some discoloration to the mounting surface. Remove one side of the tape protector to apply it to the bottom of the mounting clip, apply pressure for 5 seconds to ensure proper adhesion. Repeat this step for the other 3 clips.

4. Place the light tubes in the clips by applying slight pressure to the back of the clip. **DO NOT** apply pressure to the tube itself, this may cause damage to the tube.

5. Mount the first 9 inch tube to the left side of your television. Remove the tape protector and firmly press each mounting clip to your installation surface.
6. Now mount the first 15 inch tube to the top of your television. Remove the tape protector and firmly press each mounting clip to your installation surface.
7. Mount the second 9 inch tube to the right side of your television. Remove the tape protector and firmly press each mounting clip to your installation surface.
8. Mount the second 15 inch tube to the bottom of your television. Remove the tape protector and firmly press each mounting clip to your installation surface.
 - **NOTE:** The object of this installation is to install the light tubes so that the reflected light is visible and the tubes are not. The tubes are installed using the mounting clips so that you can swivel each tube to achieve the best lighting effect possible.
9. Starting with the left hand side tube, connect each tube to the next using the included mini USB power cables. The bottom tube should be the last tube connected so that it can be easily connected to the control box.
10. Mount the control box in a location where the last power cable can easily connect to it. This step is going to be unique to each installation based on how your television is mounted.
11. Once the control box is mounted, connect the last lead power cable to your control box.
12. Now connect the infrared (IR) receiver to the control box, and mount it in a location where it is free from any interference and has a clear line of sight.
 - **NOTE:** The included IR receiver works together with the included remote to operate the kit, and allows you to keep your control box hidden.
13. Lastly, plug the included power supply into a standard wall outlet and connect the mini jack to the control box.
14. Now that your kit is installed and powered, turn the kit on using the included remote and test the kit again for full functionality.
 - **NOTE:** If your remote is not controlling the kit properly, you may need to adjust the IR receiver to achieve the best result.

Replacing the battery

To replace the battery for the remote, simply pull the battery housing out from the bottom of the remote and switch the old battery out with a new one. The correct battery size for this remote is a circular 2025 battery. Replacing the battery will not affect your saved custom colors.

ONE YEAR NON-TRANSFERRABLE LIMITED WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER

LEDGlow Lighting, LLC ("LEDGlow") warrants to the original retail consumer purchaser, and not any other purchaser or subsequent owner, that this Product will be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of **one (1) year** from the purchase date. **This warranty does not cover any Product that is (1) installed incorrectly, or (2) damaged by collisions, vandalism, other accidents, or similar causes.**

For a period of **one (1) year** from the date of purchase, at no charge to the Purchaser, LEDGlow will repair or replace this Product if it is determined by LEDGlow to be defective. After the warranty period, the Purchaser must pay all charges for parts and labor.

Coverage under this warranty is only valid within the United States, including its territories, as well as in certain other countries. Purchasers should check our website, www.LEDGlow.com, to determine the warranty coverage in the countries in which they are located.

LEDGlow does **not warrant the installation** of the Product, which is the sole responsibility of the Purchaser. Installation should be done by licensed professionals. Improper installation may cause damage to the Product and any vehicle in which it is installed, and may cause burns and electrical injury to individuals. LEDGlow's warranty does not cover any expenses incurred in removing Products that are defective or re-installing replacement Products in their place.

During the warranty period, to have the Product repaired or replaced, the Purchaser must return the Product, freight prepaid by the Purchaser, to LEDGlow (but for customers in the contiguous United States, LEDGlow will pay the shipping charges if any Product fails during the first thirty (30) days after purchase). The Product must be returned in its original carton or in a similar package affording an equal degree of protection. LEDGlow will return the repaired or replaced Product, freight prepaid, to the Purchaser. LEDGlow does not provide Purchasers with temporary replacement units during the warranty period or at any other time.

This limited warranty is non-transferrable and will automatically terminate if the original retail consumer purchaser resells the Product or transfers the vehicle on which the Product is installed. An "original retail consumer purchaser" is a person who originally purchases the Product, or a gift recipient of a new Product that is in its original packaging and unopened.

This limited warranty is subject to all of the following terms and conditions:

1.
